WAYNE COUNTY ASSESSOR'S OFFICE HOMESTEAD/DISABILITY EXEMPTION APPLICATION SCHEDULE

Wayne County Assessor Eric L. Hodges, will be at the Wayne County Senior Citizen Centers to assist those property owners that are eligible to sign up for the \$20,000 Assessed Valuation Homestead Exemption. Property owners that have been a resident of West Virginia for the two calendar years previous to this calendar year, and have lived on the property for six consecutive months are eligible for this benefit provided that they are 65 years of age on or before June 30, 2016. Property owners that are totally and permanently disabled and have proof of their disability may apply regardless of age. If a property owner has previously signed up for the Exemption, there is no need to re-apply unless they have moved.

You may also apply at the Assessor's office between July 1 and December 1, 2015. Our office is open 8AM to 4PM Monday through Friday, except Thursdays when the hours are 8AM to 7PM. If there are individuals that are physically unable to travel either to the Assessor's Office, or one of the Senior Centers, you may call the Office at 272-6349, and arrange for the Assessor to visit your home and complete the necessary forms.

Mr. Hodges states that the savings to eligible persons will be approximately \$250 for the 2015 tax year. If you have any questions regarding your eligibility for the Homestead Exemption, please call 272-6349.
